WHAT TO DO? **DELAY** 1. BIRTH OF A BOVINE ANIMAL AT THE LIVESTOCK OPERATION Identify the animal: - Affix ear tags ordered from ATQ. In the 7 days following the birth of the animal or before its departure from the livestock operation, whichever comes first. Pasture-born: In the **5 months** following the birth of the animal or before its departure from the pasture, whichever comes first. In the 7 days following the identification of the animal or When ear tags are affixed, activate by informing ATQ of: before its departure from the livestock operation, whichever - Your stakeholder number<sup>1</sup> or name and address; comes first. The *premises number*<sup>2</sup> where the animal is located; The tag numbers; The date the animal was tagged; The mention that it is a bovine; The category of the bovine animal; The birth date of the bovine animal; - The sex of the bovine animal. 2. From outside If the animal is identified only by an electronic (RFID) tag: Quebec. Complete the identification by ordering a printed tag bearing the same number as Order the tag upon the animal's arrival and affix the tag as the electronic tag soon as it arrives. 0R Order the tag upon the animal's arrival and affix the tag as Complete the identification by affixing a blank tag and write on it the soon as it arrives. corresponding electronic (RFID) tag number. If the animal is not identified with 2 official tags<sup>3</sup> (electronic tag and printed tag): From outside Canada. Upon the animal's arrival or before its importation. If the animal is only identified with an official electronic tag, complete the identification by affixing a blank tag and write on it the corresponding electronic (RFID) tag number 0R - Affix a complete set of tags.

- 1 The "stakeholder number" is the number assigned by ATQ to a cattle owner or custodian.
- 2 The "premises number" is the number assigned by ATQ to a location where cattle are kept.
- 3 An official tag is a tag officially recognized by the authorities of the animal's country of origin and in compliance with the requirements of part XV of Health of Animals Regulations.

Inform ATQ of:  - Your stakeholder number or name and address;  - The premises number from which the animal departed;  - The tag numbers;  - The departure date;  - The name of the subsequent owner or custodian;  - The premises number or address of the destination premises (if this information is not available, please indicate the name and address of the carrier and the registration number of the vehicle in which the animal is transported).	
. LOSS OF	TAGS	
The bovine animal has lost one or two tags.	A. Loss of a printed tag:     Immediately order a new printed tag from ATQ with the same number as the electronic (RFID) tag and affix it as soon as it arrives	Affix as soon as the tag is received.
	Immediately affix a blank tag and write on it the corresponding electronic (RFID) tag number.	As soon as the loss of the tag is noted.
	B. Loss of an electronic tag:         - Immediately order a new electronic tag from ATQ with the same number as the printed tag         OR	Affix as soon as the tag is received.
	- Immediately affix two new tags.	As soon as the loss of the tag is noted.
	C. Loss of both tags: - Affix two new tags.	As soon as the loss of the tags is noted.

5. BOVINE	ANIMAL HAS DISAPPEARED	
	Inform ATQ of:  - Your stakeholder number or name and address;  - The premises number where the animal was held;  - The tag numbers;  - The mention that it is a bovine;  - The sex of the bovine animal;  - The date the animal's disappearance was noted.	In the <b>7 days</b> following the identification of the animal or before its departure from the livestock operation, whichever comes first.
6. BOVINE	ANIMAL HAS DIED ON THE LIVESTOCK OP	ERATION
	If the carcass is not salvaged, <b>inform ATQ of:</b> - Your <i>stakeholder number</i> or name and address; - The <i>premises number</i> where the animal was found dead; - The tag numbers; - The mention that it is a bovine; - The date the animal died or when death was noticed.	Within <b>7 days</b> of the death of the animal or from the date that its death was noted.
7. DESTRO	YED, LOST OR NON-FUNCTIONING TAGS	
	Inform ATQ of the tag numbers.	Within 30 days following the event.
8. CESSATI	ON OF ACTIVITIES	,
	Inform ATQ of:  - Your stakeholder number or name and address; - The name and address of the livestock operation.  Return tags to ATQ.	Within 30 days following the cessation of activities.
9. TRANSF	ER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE LIVESTOCK OF	PERATION
	Inform ATQ of: - Your or name and address; - The name and address of the livestock operation;	Within <b>30 days</b> following the transfer of ownership of the livestock operation.

## THE FOLLOWING PRACTICES ARE NOT PERMITTED:

- To affix tags<sup>4</sup> on bovine animals not located at the livestock operation for which they were delivered;
- To give away or sell tags;
- To remove tags affixed to a bovine animal;
- To keep a bovine animal tagged with:
  - · a number already attributed to another bovine animal;
  - · a number destined for use with sheep or cervids;
- To remove or cause to be removed from a livestock operation any bovine animal not identified in accordance with regulations;
- To transport or cause to be transported or to receive or cause to be received any bovine animal coming from within Quebec and which does not have at least one tag affixed in accordance with regulations;
- To transmit to ATQ any incorrect, illegible or incomplete information.

## NOTE

In cases where the present text differs from that of the *Regulation respecting the identification and traceability of certain animals*, the legal text will prevail.
