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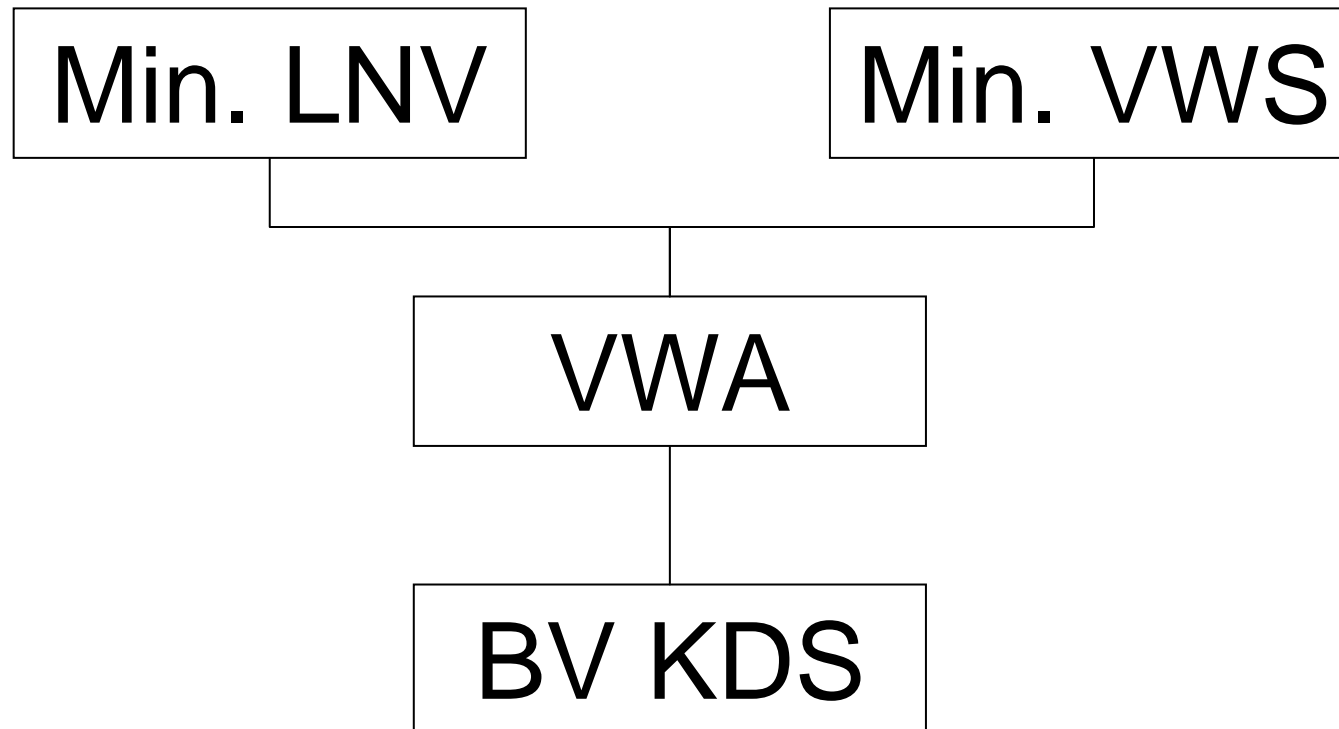
- Board

The relations between the organisations

KDS



Contract VWA vs. BV KDS

- 01 January 2006
- Final decision by VWA veterinarian
- VWA supervises BV KDS
- VWA approves the quality system
- BV KDS maintains secrecy
- Inspection results are property of VWA
- Scheduled meetings with VWA

Independency and quality

- Composition of the board
- Accredited by Dutch Accreditation Council
- Accreditation standard is ISO/IEC 17020
- Education of the Officials Auxiliaries
- No conflict in interests

Contract VWA vs. BV KDS

Finances are arranged in the following manner:

- Invoice from BV KDS to VWA
- Invoices from VWA to slaughterhouses
- Slaughterhouses pays VWA
- VWA pays BV KDS

Implementation of pm inspection

- Request for pm meat inspection
- Planning division makes a timetable
 - Slaughterhouses
 - Self slaughtering butchers
- Timetable is send to employees

Implementation of pm inspection

- Slaughterhouses
 - Teams
 - One contact person
 - Results on internal form

Implementation of pm inspection

- Self slaughtering butchers
 - Route (automatic plan system)
 - Combine activity (BSE sampling)
 - Results on VWA form
 - Results on internal form

Findings of pm inspection

- Suitable for human consumption
- Not suitable for human consumption
- Final decision by veterinarian VWA
