
Marketing Healthy Calves



- Vaccinate the home herd against common diseases (IBR, BVD, etc.)
- Keep calving facilities clean, dry and well bedded
- Disinfect navels with a 5-10 % iodine solution
- Colostrum : Feed 4-6 litres per day, warm, for the first 3 days
- Whole milk: Feed 4-6 litres per day, warm, until calf leaves farm
- drafts or humidity, well bedded with dry litter Calves are housed individually in a clean and dry environment, without
- swollen, wet of infected navels

Calves should be 7 to 10 days old before being trucked

Do not market calves that :

- swollen joints or lameness
- have diarrhea
- have coughing, rapid or laboured breathing
